<u>Payment Plan</u>: NWCU does not offer a scholarship program, but does provide an affordable payment plan. Students pay an initial payment upon enrollment of \$995.00, which includes the LexisNexis subscription, one-time materials fee, administrative fee, and first of twelve tuition payments. Students also submit eleven personal checks in the amount of \$325.00 each, postdated for each following month.

<u>Additional Costs</u>: Students must purchase required texts and materials as shown on the required book list on our website. Students must arrange for a proctor for final exams proctors and must pay proctoring fees, if applicable. Upon graduation, students may order J.D. degree suitable for framing, at a current cost of \$100.

<u>State Bar of California fees</u>: Students must pay fees to the State Bar of California, such as for registration as a law student, First-Year Law Students' Exam, Bar Exam, applications for attorney licensing, etc. Please check the State Bar website for information about fees and becoming a licensed attorney in California.
